**Change Description**

On July 9, 2012, the Controlling Board approved release of Clean Ohio Revitalization Fund Program Grant funds from fund 7003, line item C19500 in the amount of \$1,142,544 from fiscal year 2013 to the City of Fostoria, Seneca County (DEV0102052-13) and \$1,084,403 from fiscal year 2013 to the City of Kent, Portage County (DEV0102054-13). Since the Controlling Board approval, Development discovered that the 11 Clean Ohio Revitalization Fund requests approved on July 9, 2012, totaling \$19,853,995, exceeded the appropriation of the current capital biennium provided in Senate Bill 312 by \$2,221,891.36. A portion of the 11 Clean Ohio Revitalization Fund requests should have referenced the additional appropriation provided in House Bill 487. To correct this, Development hereby respectfully requests a non-substantive change to revise the legislative reference from Senate Bill 312 to House Bill 487 for two of the July 9, 2012 requests: DEV0102052-13 and DEV0102054-13. This revision of bill number will reconcile appropriation balances without exceeding the available appropriation for line item C19500 for the current capital biennium provided by either bill. At the time of approval, balances based on revised bill references would have totaled \$5,055.64 in remaining appropriation provided by Senate Bill 312 and \$9,773,053 in remaining appropriation provided by House Bill 487. Another request was made on November 18, 2013 and Controlling Board approved release of \$6,515,589 in Clean Ohio Revitalization Fund Program Grant funds from fund 7003, line item C19500 for five projects that reference House Bill 487. This additional approval along with the current requested revisions will result in \$3,257,464 remaining appropriation for the current capital biennium provided by House Bill 487. All other terms and conditions of the requests are the same as presented to Controlling Board for approval.
